## **Adroddiad Blynnyddol Cronfa Ymddiriedolaeth Budd Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Statkraft**

### **Alltwalis 2020**

Sefydlwyd Cronfa Ymddiriedolaeth Budd Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Statkraft Alltwalis i reoli a dosbarthu cronfa gymunedol a sefydlwyd gan Statkraft o fewn ardal etholaeth Llanfihangel ar Arth. Mae cwmni Statkraft wedi ymrwymo i dalu swm o £75,000 yn flynyddol i'r Gronfa dros oes y cynllun sef 25 mlynedd er lles y gymuned leol. Bydd y swm yma yn cynyddu os oes yna gynnydd yn y mynegrif prisiau manwerth. Ar ddechrau 2020 cyfrannodd cwmni Statkraft swm o £100,414 i'r gronfa.


Mae Meinir Evans wedi ei phenodi fel Gweinydd yd i'r Gronfa

### Amcanion y gronfa yw:

- Ariannu cynlluniau sydd yn creu cymuned ddirgrynnol yn cynnwys cynlluniau sydd â ffocws amgylcheddol, addysgol ac sydd yn gynlluniau sydd yn gwella ar y gymuned yn cynnwys gweithgareddau awyr agored.
- Bydd y Gronfa yn cefnogi ond gwerth 50% o gynlluniau a ddylid eu cyllido gan Gyngor Sir Gaerfyrddin.

### Ceisiadau rhoddwyd cymorth i yn 2020

Ers ei sefydlu mae'r Gronfa wedi cefnogi amrywiaeth o gynlluniau a gwasanaethau led led ardal etholaeth Llanfihangel ar Arth. Cefnogwyd 14 cais yn ystod blwyddyn 2020 a gwrrthodwyd 1 cais gan eu bod ddim yn cwrdd gyda thermau ac amodau'r Gronfa.



## Cafodd y ceisiadau canlynol eu cefnogi yn ystod 2020:

### Banc Bwyd Llandysul,

Cefnogwyd £10,000 tuag at y gost o ddosbarthu pecynnau bwyd o ffrwyth a llysiau i 60 o deuluoedd difreintiedig yr ardal. Yn ogystal cafodd rhai gwirfoddolwyr gefnogaeth ar gyfer costau i gludo nwyddau a phrescriptiwn i drigolion a oedd yn hunan ynysu.



"Bu cyfnodau clo 2020 yn her mawr i'r mwyafrif o deuluoedd yng Nghymru, ond i rai roedd y sefyllfa yn anodd iawn iawn. Wrth i'r nifer o deuluoedd a oedd yn gorfol defnyddio Banc Bwyd Llandysul gynyddu, mi ddaeth yn amlwg bod yna angen am fwy o fwyd ffresh. Roedd yn anoddach teithio hefyd yn y clo ac roedd llawer yn ofni mynd i'r siop ac yn ei chael hi'n heriol gallu archebu slot i gael bwyd i'r cartref gan yr archfarchnadoedd. Roedd llawer iawn o bobl hefyd yn byw bywyd unig iawn a ddim yn gweld neb o wythnos i wythnos. Ynghanol yr heriau yma mi ddechreuodd Cristnogion yn ardal Dyffryn Teifi gasglu arian i brynu bocsys o fwyd ffresh i deuluoedd difreintiedig yr ardal am £10 y bocs gen Cardigan Bay Trading, sy'n gwmni lleol. Wrth i'r angen dyfu mi bartnerodd y Cristnogion o Ffynnon gyda Christnogion Banc Bwyd Llandysul i geisio sicrhau cyfalaf i wasanaethu degau o deuluoedd bregus yn yr ardal. Erbyn diwedd cyfnod y grant £10,000 dderbyniodd Banc Bwyd Llandysul gen Statkraft roedd dros 60 o deuluoedd yn cael eu gwasanaethu pob wythnos gyda person serchog o'r capeli a'r eglwysi yn dod â sgwrs a bocs o fwyd ffresh i'w drws. Roedd hyn yn cynnal llawer o'r teuluoedd a'r unigolion hŷn ac yn ffordd i'r eglwys allu ymateb yn ymarferol i amryw o anghenion oedd yn codi. Mi wnaeth alluogi eglwys Ffynnon i adeiladu ar y gwaith yn 2021 gyda grant arall o £10,000 gen Moondance. Roedd yn gymorth mawr i'r cais hwnnw bod y gwaith wedi gallu dechrau yn barod."

## Canolfan Canŵio Llandysul Paddlers



Hoffai'r pwylgor Clwb Canŵio Padlwyr Llandysul ddiolch i banel grant Statkraft am gyfrannu £18,000 tuag at gost archebu bws mini newydd . Mae'r bws mini wedi cael ei ddefnyddio yn ystod y pandemig i gludo pobl heb gludiant i feddygfa ac apwyntiadau ysbyty gan wifoddolwyr. Ers i'r Ganolfan Canŵio ail agor a ail gychwyn ar gystadlu mae'r bws mini wedi cludo cystadleuwyr lleol i nifer o gystadleuthau yn cynnwys Gwlad yr Haf, Swydd Stafford, Bala ar Alban. Mae

cystadleuwyr lleol hefyd yn hyfforddi un waith yr wythnos yng Nghaerdydd ac yn cael eu cludo yno yn y bws mini. Mae derbyn cyfraniad tuag at gost y bws mini wedi neud gwahaniaeth enfawr i ni fel clwb a bydd yn adnodd gwerthfawr i ni am flynyddoedd i ddod. Mae derbyn cyfraniad o £2,500 tuag at gostau peiriant torri porfa yn ein galluogi i gynnal a chadw'r tir ar safle Canolfan Canwio Llandysul Paddlers.

## Cae Chwarae Parc y Glyn Llanfihangel ar Arth

Cefnogwyd cais gwerth £1,208 gan Gymdeithas Cae Chwarae Parc y Glyn i archebu adnoddau ar gyfer twrnamant pêl droed. **Mae'r Cae Chwarae bellach ar agor i'r cyhoedd ar ôl i waith cael ei wneud i wella cyflwr y borfa dros y misoedd diwethaf. Defnyddiwyd arian Statkraft i ariannu'r gwaith hwn Mae'r pwylgor wedi bod yn brysur yn tacluso o gwmpas y cae ac yn edrych ymlaen at gynnal digwyddiad pan fydd hi'n ddiogel i'w wneud hynny. Rydym yn edrych ymlaen at ddefnyddio'r offer a brynwyd gydag arian Statkraft, sef pabell fawr, gazebo, marciwr llinell ac uchelseinydd. Rydym yn ddiolchgar iawn am gefnogaeth Statkraft sy'n ein galluogi i sicrhau bod y cae yn gwasanaethu'r gymuned.**

## Cylch Meithrin Llanllwni

Oherwydd covid 19 buodd y cylch ar gau am 6 mis, rhwng colli incwm a methu codi arian rydym yn gwerthfawrogi'n fawr y cymorth y mae Cronfa Cymunedol Budd Fferm Wynt Statkraft Alltwalis wedi'i roi i ni ac mae e wedi cymryd rhywfaint o'r pwysau arnom yn ariannol.'

## Grŵp Adfywiad Pencader a'r Cylch

Gwnaeth y gronfa barhau i ariannir cost o argraffu a dosbarthu newyddlen Clecs Bro Cader: 'Mae grant gan Statkraft wedi galluogir grŵp i argraffu Papur 'Clecs Bro Cader' 6 gwaith pob blwyddyn, gyda 1100 o gopïau yn cael ei hargraffu a'u dosbarthu yn cynnig newyddion ar ddigwyddiadau'r ardal ar gyfer preswylwyr etholaeth Llanfihangel ar Arth. Nid yw byth wedi bod yn fwriad i godi tal am y Clecs ac nid yw incwm o hysbysebion yn ddigon i dalu am y gost felly mae derbyn grant gan y Gronfa wedi bod yn amhrisiadwy. Mae cadw'r gymuned yn ymwybodol o wasanaethau lleol yn holl bwysig yn enwedig yn ystod amser ansicr fel y presennol.'

## Scowntaid Llandysul

Cefnogwyd cais gwerth £810 ar gyfer archebu peyll ac offer gwersylla ar gyfer grwp Scowntaid Llandysul. Mae cyfyngiadau'r pandemig ddim wedi caniatau i ni ddefnyddio'r peyll yn ystod 2020. ## **Statkraft Alltwalis Wind Farm Community Benefit Trust Fund Annual Report 2020**

**Statkraft Alltwalis Wind Farm Community Benefit Trust Fund** was established to manage and distribute the community fund set up by Statkraft within the electoral ward of Llanfihangel ar Arth. Statkraft have committed to paying the annual sum of £75,000 for 25 years over the life of the project for the benefit of the local community. This sum is linked to the retail price index and will increase annually in accordance with any increases in the retail price index. During 2020 Statkraft transferred the sum of £100,414 to the fund.


Meinir Evans is the appointed Administrator for the Trust.

**The aims of the Trust are to:**

- Fund activities that create a vibrant community including those with a focus on environmental, educational and community improvement projects, including outdoor activities.
- To provide not more than 50% of matched funding for community projects and initiatives that should ordinarily be funded by Carmarthenshire County Council

**Applications approved in 2020:**

Since its inception the Statkraft Alltwalis Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund has supported a wide range of initiatives and services from across the area of the Llanfihangel ar Arth electoral division. During 2020 14 applications were approved and 1 application was rejected as it did not meet the Fund's terms and conditions.



The following applications have been supported by Statkraft Alltwalis Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund during 2020.

### Llandysul Food Bank

A grant of £10,000 was donated towards the costs of distributing fresh fruit and vegetables to 60 disadvantaged families in the area. In addition to this contribution some volunteers were provided with expenses for delivering food and prescription to vulnerable people that were self isolating during the pandemic.



The 2020 lockdown periods have been a major challenge for most families in Wales, but for some the situation was very difficult. As the number of families having to use Llandysul Food bank increased, it became clear that there was a need for more fresh food. It was also more difficult to travel during the lock down and many were afraid to go to the shop and found it challenging to be able to order a slot to get food to the home from the supermarkets. A great many people also lived a very lonely life and did not see anyone from week to week. In the middle of these challenges Christians in the Teifi Valley area started collecting money to buy boxes of fresh food for the area's disadvantaged families for £10 per box gen Cardigan Bay Trading, which is a local company. As the need grew the Christians from Ffynnon partnered with the Christians of the Llandysul Food Bank to try to secure capital to serve tens of vulnerable families in the area. The £10,000 grant received by Statkraft Alltwalis Community Wind Farm enabled 60 families to be greeted by a friendly face of the dedicated team of volunteers from chapels and churches who delivered a box of fresh food to their door each week. This sustained many families and elderly residents and was a way for the church to be able to respond in practice to a range of needs that arose. It enabled Ffynnon church to build on the work in 2021 with another grant of £10,000 from the Moondance Foundation. It was a great help to that application that the work had already been able to start."

## Llandysul Paddlers Canoe Club



The committee at Llandysul paddlers would like to thank the Statkraft grant panel for awarding us £18,000 towards a new minibus at Llandysul paddlers.

The new minibus has been used in the pandemic to transfer people without transport to doctors' surgery and hospital appointments driven by volunteer drivers.

Now that we have managed to re-open the centre and club the minibus has been used to transport the local paddlers to compete in races in Somerset, Staffordshire, Bala and Scotland.

We also take the paddlers to Cardiff once a week to train on the White water at the man-made site.

The minibus has made a huge difference to the club, and we look forward to using it for many years to come. Receiving a contribution of £2,500 towards the costs of a mower enables us to maintain the grounds at the Llandysul Paddlers site.

## Cae Chwarae Parc y Glyn Llanfihangel ar Arth

An application by Cymdeithas Cae Chwarae Parc y Glyn Playing Field Llanfihangel ar Arth worth £1,208 was supported to purchase equipment for the football tournament. The playing field has re opened to the public following recent improvements to the grounds funded by the Statkraft Alltwalis Community Fund. **Members of the committee have been busy maintaining the field and look forward to arranging activities when it will be safe to do so. We look forward to making use of the marquee, gazebo, sound system and line marker equipment purchased by the grant received. We are extremely thankful to the fund for your support that ensures that the playing field is available for the community.**

## Cylch Meithrin Llanllwni

## Cross Roads Sir Gâr – Young carers grant application to fund activities

When asked, 100% of young carers said that the day gave them some time out of their caring role, and 93% said it gave them time to socialise and have fun.



## Pencader and District Regeneration Group

The Fund continued to support the costs of publishing and distributing Clecs Bro Cader newsletter: **'The Statkraft funding has enabled this group to publish the local newsletter "Clecs Bro Cader" six times a year, it has increased circulation to 1,100 and is keeping residents up to date with events in the Parish. It has never been an option to charge residents for the newsletter and advertising income is not enough to keep the publication going so the Statkraft funding has been invaluable. It is so important in these uncertain times to keep residents informed and Clecs Bro Cader tries to do this'.**

## Llandysul Scout Group

An application by the Llandysul Scout Group worth £810 for the purchase of tents and camping equipment was supported. **The pandemic restrictions have not allowed us to use the tents during 2020. Despite this the Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorers have been meeting outdoors on a regular basis and are hoping to make use of the tents soon. We are very grateful to the Statkraft Fund that receiving the grant has made a big difference to us.**

## Ysgol Cae'r Felin

Once again we as a school have been very fortunate and have benefited from the generosity of the Statkraft Fund receiving a grant of £1,524. We had to restructure classes and as a result more tables were needed within classes to enable afternoon sessions in the format of the new curriculum with three age groups working together during theme sessions and challenges. In addition, the school council raised the need to separate a football area at the rest of the yard to ensure safety and came up with the idea of plastic barriers to create a safe area. As a result of covid these had to be used to separate the pupils to adhere to covid regulations ensuring that all children were able to be out in the yard at the same time. We look forward in September to being able to make the intended use of the barriers to create a football area in the backyard.



## **Ysgol Eglwys Llanllwni**

An application worth £4,451 was supported for the purpose of purchasing outdoor educational equipment, a new classroom floor and painting the classroom.
