Sefydlwyd Cronfa Ymddiriedolaeth Budd Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Statkraft Alltwalis i reoli a dosbarthu cronfa gymunedol a sefydlwyd gan Statkraft o fewn ardal etholaeth Llanfihangel ar Arth. Mae cwmni Statkraft wedi ymrwymo i dalu swm o £75,000 yn flynyddol i'r Gronfa dros oes y cynllun sef 25 mlynedd er lles y gymuned leol. Bydd y swm yma yn cynyddu os oes yna gynnydd yn y mynegrif prisiau manwerth. Ar ddechrau 2024 cyfrannodd cwmni Statkraft swm o £130,376.60 i'r gronfa.

- Bydd y Gronfa yn cefnogi ond gwerth 50% o gynlluniau a ddylid eu cyllido gan Gyngor Sir Gaerfyrddin.

- Prosiectau effeithlonrwydd ynni neu ynni adnewyddadwy, megis inswleiddio, bwyleri effeithlon neu osodiadau ynni adnewyddadwy ar raddfa fach ar gyfer adnoddau cymunedol.

Nid yw'r rhestr uchod yn hollgynhwysol ac fe'i darperir i roi syniadau yn unig.

Mae'n ofynnol i ymgeiswyr gael cyfansoddiad ysgrifenedig, cyfres o reolau, neu ddogfen lywodraethol a chyfrif banc neu gymdeithas adeiladu, a gedwir yn enw'r sefydliad, sydd ar waith cyn gwneud cais am grant. Bydd angen i ymgeiswyr hefyd ddarparu tri dyfynbris ar gyfer holl gostau'r prosiect a 2 ddyfynbris ar gyfer costau hyd at £10k.

CEISIADAU A GEFNOGWYD YN 2024

Mae'r prosiectau sydd wedi cael cymorth grantiau yn 2024 yn cynnwys, adnewyddu Festri Capel Nonni, a chymorth i'r Cylchoedd Meithrin yn Llanllwni a Phencader a chostau offer a llogi caeau chwarae i Glwb Pêl Droed Adran Iau Pencader, yn esiamplau o'r gefnogaeth y Gronfa yn ystod 2024. Cefnogwyd 16 cais yn ystod y flwyddyn calendr 2024 ac amlinellir sut mae'r Gronfa yn neud gwahaniaeth yn y gymuned yn yr Adroddiad Blyneddol yma.

Canolfan Deulu Pencader

Dyfarnwyd grant tuag at gostau Clwb Bwyd yr haf ac offer ac adnoddau chwarae a chrefft.



Mae'r rhan fwyaf o'n teuluoedd ar incwm isel a'u cyflogaeth wedi'u cynnal gyda budd-daliadau, roedd rhieni'n pryderu am y gost o gael eu plant gartref ar gyfer yr haf, eu bwydo, prynu gwisg ysgol, a diwrnodau allan fel nad oedd eu plant yn teimlo'n eithriadol. Gallai rhieni gadw arian i fynd ar ein taith, ac fe wnaethom hefyd geisio helpu rhai teuluoedd gyda rhai bwyd a sudd i ychwanegu i'w pecyn cinio. Gwnaeth y plant hyn

wir gwerthfawrogi'r adnoddau ac offer celf a chrefft. Roedd yn hyfryd i weld nhw chwarae heb ei ffonau. Dros y gwyliau gwnaethom 200 brecwast a 150 cinio a sicrhau bod ein cypyrddau yn llawn. Felly diolch am eich cyfraniad, mae wir wedi neud gwahaniaeth i deuluoedd yr ardal.

Festri Capel Nonni : Derbyniodd Capel Nonni grant tuag at y gost o baentio'r festri a gwella system gwresogi.

Dwy flynedd yn ôl fe wnaethom adnewyddu'r Festri i ddelio gyda lleithder er mwyn sicrhau dyfodol yr adeilad. Cytunwyd i baentio'r welydd allannol gyda paint arbenigol Wallflex HB gan Polycote gyda chynnwys arbennig sydd yn gwrthsefyll dŵr a lleihau lleithder. Felly, mae hyn yn caniatáu i'r welydd anadlu heb amharu ar ansawdd y paent. Mae defnyddio'r paent yma wedi sicrhau ein bod yn gallu gwresogi'r Festri yn fwy effeithiol. Mae derbyn y grant gan Statkraft wedi ein galluogi i gwblhau'r gwaith.



Canolfan Gymunedol a Chelfyddydol y Pwerdy:

Cefnogwyd cais i godi ymwybyddiaeth o weithgareddau'r Pwerdy ynghyd â lleihau costau cynnal a darparu offer technegol i gynnis cyfarfodydd hybrid.



Mae'r Canolfan Gymunedol a Chelfyddydol y Pwerdy'n elwa o gymorth ariannol Statkraft mewn llawer o ffyrdd. Bydd y wybodaeth ychwanegol a fydd yn cael ei harddangos ar ymyl y lleoliad yn pwysleisio'r hyn sydd ar gael yn y cyfleuster.

Byddwn yn lleihau ein costau refeniw gan ein bod wedi cymryd y ddau adeilad dan yr un cyflenwr trydan sydd yn arbed oddeutu £300 y mis ar gostau trydan. Mae gennym nawr y gallu i gynnal cyfarfodydd Hybrid o'r Pwerdy oherwydd rhodd monitor mawr 48" gan Ysgol Bro Teifi a chefnogaeth Statkraft i archebu troli symudol newydd a cheblau cysylltu.

Clwb Pêl Droed Adran Iau Pencader: Cefnogwyd costau llogi caeau astro ac offer ar gyfer Adran Iau Clwb Pêl Droed Pencader.



Rydyn ni'n hynod o ffodus i fod wedi derbyn grant tuag at offer a llogi'r cae astro, gan ein galluogi i chwarae ein gemau cartref pan mae'r cae arferol yn rhy wlyb. Heb gefnogaeth hael Statkraft, ni fyddai ein plant wedi gallu chwarae eu gemau cartref y tymor hwn. Fel clwb sy'n tyfu'n gyson, rydyn ni'n defnyddio llawer o offer. Wrth i fwy o blant ymuno â ni, a gyda newidiadau rheolau a rheoliadau gan Gymdeithas Bêl Droed Cymru, mae'n dod yn fwyfwy anodd i gadw i fyny gyda'r adnoddau sydd eu hangen. Gan ein bod mewn ardal incwm isel, rydyn ni'n ymwybodol na allwn ofyn am fwy gan rieni. Mae'n hollbwysig i ni fod y clwb yn gynhwysol ac ar gael i bawb, na ddylai unrhyw blentyn gael ei adael allan. Rydyn ni'n hynod ddiolchgar am haelioni Statkraft. Mae'r gefnogaeth wedi gwneud gwahaniaeth gwirioneddol ac wedi ein galluogi i barhau i dyfu a ffynnu fel clwb. Diolch o galon am fod yn rhan o'n taith.

Clwb Canwio Llandysul Paddlers Cefnogwyd cais ar gyfer costau gwersi nofio cyfnod sylfaen Ysgol Eglwys Llanllwni, dyma eu neges o ddiolch. 'Ar ran dosbarth Nonni, hoffwn ddweud diolch enfawr am y rhodd ariannol sydd wedi fy nghalluogi i fynd â'r plant i nofio. Mae'r plant wedi bod wrth eu boddau yn mynd i nofio bob wythnos ac mae'r cynydd ym mhob plentyn wedi bod yn aruthrol. Teimlaf yn gryf bod nofio yn sgil hanfodol, yn anffodus nid yw'n opsiwn i nifer o deuluoedd dyddiau yma efo costau popeth yn cynyddu.'



Cylch Meithrin Llanllwni –



Gwnaeth y Cylch elwa'n fawr yn sgil derbyn cefnogaeth o £10,000 oddi wrth Gronfa Statkraft tuag at gostau rhedeg y Cylch. Rydym wedi cynnig amrywiaeth o gystadlaethau yn yr Eisteddfod ar gyfer grwpiau gwahanol o bobl yn yr ardal o oedran meithrin hyd at oedolion. Rydym yn cynnwys cystadleuaeth lenyddol ar gyfer dysgwyr. Mae cystadlaethau llwyfan a chystadlaethau celf a llawysgrifen er mwyn ceisio cynnwys cymaint o bobl â phosib. Heb y grant ni fyddwn wedi gallu cynnig yr amrywiaeth eang honno o gystadlaethau.

STATKRAFT ALLTWALIS WIND FARM COMMUNITY BENEFIT TRUST FUND ANNUAL REPORT 2024

Statkraft Alltwalis Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund was established to manage and distribute the community fund set up by Statkraft within the electoral ward of Llanfihangel ar Arth. Statkraft have committed to paying the annual sum of £75,000 for 25 years over the life of the project for the benefit of the local community. This sum is linked to the retail price index and will increase annually by any increases in the retail price index. During 2024 Statkraft transferred the sum of £130,376.60 to the fund.

AIMS OF THE FUND:

- Fund activities that create a vibrant community including those with a focus on environmental, educational and community improvement projects, including outdoor activities.
- To provide not more than 50% of matched funding for community projects and initiatives that should ordinarily be funded by Carmarthenshire County Council

Some examples of the type of projects the Fund will support are given below:

- Projects to improve public amenities e.g. community halls, sports facilities;
- Environmental and wildlife projects including projects to improve public parks and open spaces;
- Activities / events to engage the local community;
- Projects that encourage and promote education, skills and opportunities for young people;
- Energy efficiency or renewable energy projects, such as insulation, efficient boilers or small-scale renewable energy installations for community amenities.

The above list is not exhaustive and is provided to give ideas only.

Eligible Organisations:

Eligible Organisations, who can apply for funding include:

- Voluntary and community groups
- Llanfihangel ar Arth Community Council and Llanllwni Community Council
- Schools and educational establishments (for projects above LEA responsibility)
- Social enterprises (including credit unions, co-operatives, social firms, community owned enterprises, community interest companies and development trusts) provided they operate on a not-for-profit basis.

Applicants are required to have a written constitution, a set of rules, or a governing document and a bank or building society account, held in the name of the organisation, in place before applying for a grant. Applicants will also need to provide three quotes for all the project costs and 2 quotes for costs that are up to £10k.

APPLICATIONS SUPPORTED IN 2024

Projects supported by grants in 2024 include the refurbishment of the Vestry at Capel Nonni Chapel and support for the Cylchoedd Meithrin in Llanllwni and Pencader and equipment and pitch hire costs for the Pencader Junior Football Team. During the 2024 calendar year, 16 applications were supported and illustrates how the fund makes a difference and is outlined in further detail within the report.

Pencader Family Centre



A grant of £500 was awarded towards the costs of the summer food programme. **‘Most of our families are on low incomes and topped up with benefits, parents were worried about the cost of having their children home for the summer holidays, feeding them, buying school uniform, and days out so their children do not feel excluded. Parents could then save to go on our trip, we also tried to help with some families with some food and juice to**

supplement their packed lunch bags. The summer holidays were a great success this year, we were very busy despite the road closures. The arts and craft equipment were greatly appreciated, especially with the older children. It was nice to see them off their phones and games. Over the summer holidays we served up 200 breakfasts, 150 lunches and restocked our cupboards to continue with this as long as we can. So, thank you. It made such a difference to our families.

Capel Nonni Chapel Vestry

A grant for painting the external walls and upgrade the heating system was supported. Two Years ago part of the Vestry was dampproofed and re plastered for the future upkeep of the building, we agreed to have the outside walls painted with Wallflex HB Paint from Polycote with special water resistant paint that controls dampness. Therefore, allowing the walls to breathe without diminishing any of its protective qualities. This has significantly reduced heat loss through the walls by greatly increasing the insulation properties of the wall. Receiving this grant from Statkraft has enabled us to do the work, thank you.



Powerhouse Community Arts Centre:

An application to support the costs of reducing running costs, improved signage to promote the facilities and equipment for offering hybrid meetings was supported.



The Pwerdy will benefit from the Statkraft funding support in many ways.

The added information signage incorporated on the outside of the premises

will highlight what the facility has on offer. It will reduce our revenue running cost re energy as we have brought the two buildings under one supplier which will save us approximately £300 a month on standing charges. We now have the ability to host Hybrid meetings from the Pwerdy due to the gifting of a large screen 48" monitor from Ysgol Bro Teifi and the support of Statkraft with a new mobile trolley and connection cabling.

Pencader Junior Football Club:

The fund supported an application for the hire costs of an astro pitch and for the purchase of equipment for Pencader Junior Football Club.



We are extremely fortunate to have received a grant towards equipment and hiring the astroturf pitch,

enabling us to play our home games when the regular pitch is too wet. Without the generous support of Statkraft, our children would not have been able to play their home games. As more children join us, and with changes to the rules and regulations from the Football Association of Wales, it is becoming increasingly difficult to keep up with the resources needed. Given that we are in a low-income area, we are aware that we cannot ask for more from parents. It is vital for us that the club is inclusive and available to everyone—no child should be left out. We are extremely grateful for the generosity of Statkraft. The support has made a real difference and has enabled us to continue to grow and thrive as a club. Thank you sincerely for being part of our journey this season. As a club that is constantly growing, we are using a lot of equipment.

An application was supported

for the costs of swimming lesson for the Foundation Phase at Ysgol Eglwys Llanllwni Church.

Here is their message of thanks. **'On behalf of the Nonni class, I would like to say a huge thank you for the grant that has enabled me to take the children swimming. The children have been thrilled to go swimming every week and the progress made by each child has been remarkable. I strongly feel that swimming is an essential skill, unfortunately, it is not an option for many families these days with costs of living rising.'**



Cylch Meithrin Llanllwni:

The Cylch benefitted from a £10,000 grant 'We are extremely grateful for the grant that allows us to continue to provide educational and enriching experiences to the pre school children of the area. The contribution ensures that the children receive varied valuable experiences on a daily basis under the Leadership of experienced and committed staff. As a result of the grant the Cylch has remained open all day on Wednesday since September 2023 and because of the result of the success of opening all day on Wednesday, we are now also open all day on Monday since April 2025 by offering affordable childcare for the families of the area. As a small charity we are reliant on the support of funders and grants such as Statkraft Alltwalis Community benefit fund really make a difference. Thank you for your support.



Cylch Meithrin Pencader: A grant of £10,000 was awarded to Cylch Meithrin Pencader.



During the year the Cylch has benefitted tremendously from the support of the Statkraft Benefit Fund. This grant has made an immense difference to us as a Cylch. As the grant allows us to keep fees low for parents. We are extremely grateful to Statkraft Community Benefit Fund for your support.

Alltwalis Community Association –



The refurbished Alltwalis Community Association received a grant to purchase new swings. This project replaced our worn out swings shows our community that we can maintain our community facilities and provide and maintain a good standard of quality and safety that is essential nowadays. Over the last year, our refurbished community building is being used more and more and is resulting in a stronger community bond.

Eisteddfod Llanfihangel ar Arth and surrounding area



An application was supported towards the costs of the local Eisteddfod. The grant was used towards prizes at the Eisteddfod to try to attract more competitors in the different departments. It was a successful eisteddfod with keen competition, especially in the local section. See a picture of Alaw Fflur Rees winning the Trophy for Tlws yr Ifanc. We have offered a variety of competitions at the Eisteddfod for different groups of people in the area from nursery age through to adulthood. We include a literary competition for learners. There are stage competitions and art and handwriting competitions to try and involve as many people as possible. Without the grant it would not have been possible to offer a wide range of competitions.

Pencader and District Regeneration Group

The Fund continued to support the costs of publishing and distributing Clecs Bro Cader newsletter: 'The Stakraft funding has enabled this group to publish the local newsletter "Clecs Bro Cader" six times a year, with 1,150 copies printed and distributed to keep residents up to date with events in the Parish and encourage them to join in with their community activities. It has never been an option to charge residents for the newsletter and advertising income is not enough to keep the publication going so the Statkraft funding has been invaluable.'
