Sefydlwyd Cronfa Ymddiriedolaeth Budd Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Statkraft Alltwalis i reoli a dosbarthu cronfa gymunedol a sefydlwyd gan Statkraft o fewn ardal etholaeth Llanfihangel ar Arth. Mae cwmni Statkraft wedi ymrwymo i dalu swm o £75,000 yn flynyddol i'r Gronfa dros oes y cynllun sef 25 mlynedd er lles y gymuned leol. Bydd y swm yma yn cynyddu os oes yna gynnydd yn y mynegrif prisiau manwerth. Ar ddechrau 2025 cyfrannodd cwmni Statkraft swm o £134,883 i'r gronfa.

- Ariannu cynlluniau sydd yn creu cymuned ddirgrynol yn cynnwys cynlluniau sydd â ffocws amgylcheddol, addysgol ac sydd yn gynlluniau sydd yn gwella ar y gymuned yn cynnwys gweithgareddau awyr agored.
- Bydd y Gronfa yn cefnogi ond gwerth 50% o gynlluniau a ddylid eu cyllido gan Gyngor Sir Gaerfyrddin.

Esiamplau o geisiadau a gefnogir:

- Prosiectau i wella cyfleusterau cyhoeddus e.e. neuaddau cymunedol, cyfleusterau chwaraeon;
- Prosiectau amgylcheddol a bywyd gwyllt gan gynnwys prosiectau i wella parciau cyhoeddus a mannau agored;
- Gweithgareddau / digwyddiadau i ymgysylltu â'r gymuned leol;
- Prosiectau sy'n annog ac yn hyrwyddo addysg, sgiliau a chyfleoedd i bobl ifanc;
- Prosiectau effeithlonrwydd ynni neu ynni adnewyddadwy, megis inswleiddio, bwyleri effeithlon neu osodiadau ynni adnewyddadwy ar raddfa fach ar gyfer adnoddau cymunedol.

Nid yw'r rhestr uchod yn hollgynhwysol ac fe'i darperir i roi syniadau yn unig.

Mae Sefydliadau Cymwys, a all wneud cais am gyllid yn cynnwys:

- Mentrau cymdeithasol (gan gynnwys undebau credyd, cwmnïau cydweithredol, cwmnïau cymdeithasol, mentrau sy'n eiddo i'r gymuned, cwmnïau buddiannau cymunedol ac ymddiriedolaethau datblygu) ar yr amod eu bod yn gweithredu ar sail ddielw. Mae'n ofynnol i ymgeiswyr gael cyfansoddiad ysgrifenedig, cyfres o reolau, neu ddogfen lywodraethol a chyfrif banc neu gymdeithas adeiladu, a gedwir yn enw'r sefydliad, sydd ar waith cyn gwneud cais am grant. Bydd angen i ymgeiswyr hefyd ddarparu tri dyfynbris ar gyfer holl gostau'r prosiect a 2 ddyfynbris ar gyfer costau hyd at £10k.

Grant Bach

Mae Grant Bach Cronfa Fferm Wynt Statkraft Alltwalis wedi sefydlu eleni er mwyn hwyluso'r broses i glybiau a chymdeithasau i ymgeisio am grantiau lan hyd £750 o werth. Bwriad y grant ydi ystyried ceisiadau ar gyfer offer, cyngherddau a digwyddiadau a thripiâu addysgiadol. (Bydd ariannu tripiâu i sefydliadau yn cael ei gyfyngu i un trip addysgiadol yn flynyddol).

CEISIADAU A GEFNOGWYD YN 2025

Cefnogwyd 18 o geisiadau yn ystod 2025, gan gynnwys cymorth i Gylchoedd Meithrin Llanllwni a Phencader, offer chwarae newydd yng Nghae Chwarae Parc y Glyn, Llanfihangel-ar-arth, costau offer a llogi caeau chwarae i Glwb Pêl-droed Adran Iau Pencader, a datblygu ardal fioamrywiaeth a bywyd gwyllt yng Nghae Hafan. Mae'r rhain yn enghreifftiau o'r gefnogaeth a ddarparwyd gan y Gronfa yn ystod 2025.

Cae Chwarae Parc y Glyn Llanfihangel ar Arth

Dyfarnwyd grant tuag at gostau prynu offer chwarae ar gyfer cae chwarae Parc y Glyn.



Mae derbyn y grant wedi rhoi hwb enfawr i'r pwyllgor ac wedi sicrhau ein bod yn gweld ffrwyth ein llafur! Rydym yn bwyllgor gweithgar iawn sy'n cynnal digwyddiadau drwy gydol y flwyddyn ac mae'n bleser gallu rhoi yn ôl i'r plant sy'n mwynhau ein digwyddiadau gan ddatblygu'r parc! Mae'r grant wedi ein galluogi i wireddu cynlluniau rydym wedi bod yn trafod ers blynnyddoedd. Mae datblygu'r parc hefyd wedi codi ymwybyddiaeth y cyhoedd o Barc y Glyn ac rydym yn gweld mwy a mwy o bobl yn defnyddio'r parc ac yn cefnogi ein digwyddiadau yn gyffredinol. Rydym yn falch i allu cynnig offer sy'n gynhwysol i blant ychydig yn hŷn ac i blant ag anableddau.

Cae Hafan – Gwarchodfan

Cefnogwyd y gost o greu Gwarchodfan ac ardal addysgiadol yng Nghae Hafan.

Fel grant allanol cyntaf y mae menter Cae Hafan wedi ei dderbyn, mae grant Statkraft wedi bod yn hollbwysig i gychwyn pethau, wedi caniatáu i ni sefydlu sylfaen gadarn ac wedi golygu ein bod yn gallu symud ymlaen mewn modd ystyrlon a gwneud cynnydd gwirioneddol ac effeithiol tuag at ein nodau hirdymor.

Mae Ymddiriedolaeth Afonydd Gorllewin Cymru wedi ein helpu i adeiladu ein gwâl dyfrgi cyntaf ar y warchodfa ac ar sail bod grant o gronfa Statkraft yn ein galluogi i greu cynefinoedd bywyd gwyllt newydd ac ardal addysgol o fewn y warchodfa, rydym yn ddiweddar iawn wedi ennill cyllid i dreialu ein rhaglenni addysg seiliedig ar natur mewn ysgolion cynradd lleol yn y blynyddoedd i ddod. Ni fyddai hyn wedi bod yn bosibl heb gymorth cronfa Statkraft.



Canolfan Calon Tysul – Cefnogwyd costau cyflwyno camerau cylch cyfun a system mynediad.

Mae prosiect Rheoli Mynediad/CCTV Calon Tysul wedi ein helpu i wneud ein Canolfan yn fwy diogel ac i gyfoethogi profiad ein defnyddwyr. Mae'r gosodiad rheoli mynediad wedi creu amgylchedd mwy diogel a rheolus i bob un o'n defnyddwyr gael mwynhau ein Gwasanaethau Iechyd a Llesiant. Mae gan bob defnyddiwr/aelod gardiau aelodaeth erbyn hyn, neu maent yn talu am fynediad wrth ein pwynt mynedfa.

Mae'r system rheoli mynediad hefyd yn ein diogelu yn ariannol, gan sicrhau bod gan bob un sy'n dod i mewn naill ai danysgrifiad gweithredol neu eu bod wedi talu'r ffi gwestai.



Mae'r system CCTV, mewn partneriaeth â'r system rheoli mynediad, wedi darparu amgylchedd mwy diogel i'r holl staff a defnyddwyr. Mae pob ardal o'r Ganolfan i'w gweld ar bob adeg, gan alluogi aelodau tîm Calon Tysul i fod yn fwy rhagweithiol, ymateb yn gyflymach ac atal damweiniau a digwyddiadau cyn iddynt ddigwydd. Mae'r CCTV hefyd yn ein cynorthwyo gyda'n cydymffurfiaeth diogelu, gan amddiffyn a chefnogi ein defnyddwyr iau drwy fod yn fwy gweladwy.

Mae'r ddau system hyn wedi cynyddu ein diogelwch yn ystod oriau agor a chau. Mae'r systemau hyn hefyd yn ein helpu i gefnogi ein gweithwyr unigol gyda haen ychwanegol o gyfyngiadau mynediad ac ymwybyddiaeth arsylwi.

Eisteddfod Llanfihangel ar Arth a'r Plwyf

Cefnogwyd cais tuag at y gost o gynnal Eisteddfod. Defnyddiwyd y grant tuag dalu am wobrau yn yr Eisteddfod er mwyn ceisio denu mwy o gystadleuwyr yn yr adrannau gwahanol.

Hoffem fel pwyllgor estyn ein diolch diffuant i Statkraft am eu cefnogaeth ariannol hael tuag at Eisteddfod Llanfihangel-ar-Arth a'r Plwyf 2026. Rydym yn hynod ddiolchgar o dderbyn y grant hwn, a fu'n gymorth mawr i sicrhau diwrnod llawn o gystadlu a dathlu talent lleol ymhlith pob oedran. Roedd yn braf gweld y neuadd yn llawn trwy gydol y dydd, gyda chefnogaeth wych gan y gymuned. Clwb Pêl Droed Adran Iau Pencader: Cefnogwyd costau llogi caeau astro ac offer ar gyfer Adran Iau Clwb Pêl Droed Pencader.



Rydyn ni'n hynod o ffodus i fod wedi derbyn grant tuag at offer a llogi'r cae astro, gan ein galluogi i chwarae ein gemau cartref pan mae'r cae arferol yn rhy wlyb. Heb gefnogaeth hael Statkraft, ni fyddai ein plant wedi gallu chwarae eu gemau cartref y tymor hwn. Fel clwb sy'n tyfu'n gyson, rydyn ni'n defnyddio llawer o offer. Wrth i fwy o blant ymuno â ni, a gyda newidiadau rheolau a rheoliadau gan Gymdeithas Bêl Droed Cymru, mae'n dod yn fwyfwy anodd i gadw i fyny gyda'r adnoddau sydd eu hangen. Gan ein bod mewn ardal incwm isel, rydyn ni'n ymwybodol na allwn ofyn am fwy gan rieni.

Cefnogwyd cais i gyd arinnau cost bws mini ar gyfer y Clwb.

Mae derbyn y grant o Gronfa Budd Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Alltwalis wedi gwneud gwahaniaeth enfawr i Clwb Canwio Paddlers Llandysul. Fe'n

galluogodd i brynu minibws 9 sedd, sydd eisoes yn cael ei ddefnyddio i gludo ein padlwyr i rasys, sesiynau hyfforddi, a gwersylloedd ar draws y DU. Mae cael cludiant dibynadwy ein hunain wedi gwella hygyrchedd i'n haelodau, wedi lleihau costau teithio, ac wedi ei gwneud hi'n haws i bobl ifanc a gwirfoddolwyr gymryd rhan mewn digwyddiadau. Mae hefyd wedi cryfhau ein hymdeimlad o gymuned a gwaith tîm, gan ganiatáu i ni barhau i hyrwyddo gweithgaredd awyr agored, llesiant a llwyddiant chwaraeon. Rydym yn hynod ddiolchgar am y gefnogaeth hon, sydd yn cael effaith gadarnhaol barhaol ar ein clwb a'n haelodau.

Cylch Meithrin Pencader: Cefnogwyd cais am grant ar gyfer y Cylch.



Mae derbyn grant gan y Gronfa wedi gwneud gwahaniaeth mawr i'r Cylch Meithrin. Yn bennaf, mae wedi cymryd pwysau ariannol oddi ar y pwyllgor, gan ein galluogi i ganolbwyntio ar redeg y cylch o ddydd i ddydd heb gymaint o bryder am gostau. Diolch i'r cyllid, rydym wedi gallu parhau i redeg y sesiynau'n rheolaidd a chynnig amgylchedd diogel, cynnes a chroesawgar i'r plant. Mae hefyd wedi ein helpu i brynu adnoddau ac offer addysgol newydd, sy'n cyfoethogi profiadau dysgu'r plant ac yn cefnogi eu datblygiad yn well. Yn ogystal, mae'r grant wedi ein galluogi i gadw ffioedd yn fforddiadwy i deuluoedd, sy'n sicrhau bod mwy o blant yn gallu mynychu'r cylch. Mae hefyd wedi rhoi mwy o sefydlogrwydd i'r staff a'r gwirfoddolwyr, gan gryfhau'r ddarpariaeth Gymraeg yn y gymuned leol. Yn gyffredinol, mae'r grant wedi sicrhau bod y Cylch Meithrin yn gallu parhau i weithredu'n llwyddiannus ac yn gynaliadwy, gan gael effaith gadarnhaol ar blant a theuluoedd yn yr ardal.

Grŵp Adfywiad Pencader ar Cylch: Gwnaeth y gronfa barhau i ariannir cost o argraffu a dosbarthu newyddlen Clecs Bro Cader: 'Mae grant gan Statkraft wedi galluogir grŵp i argraffu Papur 'Clecs Bro Cader' 6 gwaith pob blwyddyn, gyda 1150 o gopiâu yn cael ei hargraffu a'u dosbarthu. Mae'r newyddlen yn cynnig newyddion ar ddigwyddiadau'r ardal ar gyfer preswylwyr etholaeth Llanfihangel ar Arth ac annog nhw i ymuno â gweithgareddau cymunedol . Nid yw byth wedi bod yn fwriad i godi tal am y Clecs ac nid yw incwm o hysbysebion yn ddigon i dalu am y gost felly mae derbyn grant gan y Gronfa wedi bod yn amhrisiadwy.'

Mae'r gwaith addurno wedi cyfrannu at greu naws croesawgar ar gyfer y Neuadd sydd yn ganolbwynt i nifer o ddigwyddiadau cymunedol a diwylliannol y pentref.



Yr Ardd: Cafodd costau creu gardd synhwyrdd eu cefnogi ynghyd â chysiau gyda Selena Walker.

Diolch i Statkraft am gefnogi'n hael drwy ddarparu cyllid tuag at yr ardd berlysiu yng ngardd gymunedol Yr Ardd, Pont Tyweli, Llandysul.

Rydym bellach yn y broses o wahodd Salena yn ôl i Yr Ardd i ddangos i ni sut i sychu'r perlysiu rydym wedi'u tyfu eleni.

Ysgol Cae'r Felin: Cytunwyd i gwelliannau i ardal allanol ac adnoddau'r ysgol ar gyfer lles corfforol a meddyliol.

Rydym wedi diweddarau ein system oleuadau tu allan i'r ysgol. Mae'r goleuadau yn rhai LED ac yn goleuo ardal allanol yr ysgol yn rhagorol. Mae hyn yn feunyddiol iawn i'r ysgol pan fydd yna weithgareddau ar ôl oriau ysgol, yn enwedig yn ystod y gaeaf. Rhedwy y prosiect dylunio dros gyfno o chwe wythnos. Briff y prosiect oedd datblygu'r ystafell ddosabrth i'w throï'n ofod sy'n hyrwyddo iechyd meddwl cadarnhaol a meddylgarwch. Yn ystod y prosiect, bu'r disgyblion yn datblygu amrywiaeth o sgiliau:

- Rhifedd: Trwy fesur a chreu cynllun graddfa o'r ystafell ddosbarth,
- Celfyddydau Mynegiannol: Trwy greu collage a threilalu gyda thechnegau paentio amrywiol;
- Llythrennedd: Trwy baratoi a chyflwyno eu canfyddiadau a'u gwaith caled i rieni mewn ffordd hyderus ac effeithiol.

Roedd y prosiect yn gyfle cyffrous i integreiddio dysgu ymarferol gyda datblygiad personol, gan roi llwyfan i ddisgyblion arddangos eu creadigrwydd a'u sgiliau cyfathrebu.



Ysgol Eglwys Llanllwni – Cefnogwyd cais Cymdeithas Rhieni ac Athrawon Llanllwni i gefngogi lles a iechyd y dysgwyr.

Gyda'ch cefnogaeth chi, rydym wedi gallu penodi aelod staff ymroddedig sy'n canolbwyntio ar hyrwyddo iechyd a lles ein disgyblion. Mae'r rôl hon hefyd yn darparu cefnogaeth hanfodol i ddisgyblion ag anghenion dysgu ychwanegol, yn ogystal â'r rhai sy'n profi pryder a heriau gyda llythrennedd emosiynol.

Mae arian grant Statkraft wedi bod yn hynod werthfawr i Sioe C.Ff.I Llanllwni, gan ein galluogi i ehangu a gwella'r digwyddiad er budd y gymuned gyfan. Gan mai sioe elusennol yw hon, mae'r cymorth ariannol yn rhoi cyfle i ni roi rhywbeth yn ôl i'r gymuned drwy greu diwrnod hwylus ac atyniadol i bawb, yn ogystal â chefnogi elusennau sy'n gwneud gwahaniaeth gwirioneddol i fywydau trigolion lleol. Llynedd, defnyddiwyd y grant i ddarparu castell bownsio a sefydlu pentref plant poblogaidd iawn, a oedd yn ychwanegu elfen newydd gyffrous i'r sioe. Hefyd, fe wnaeth ein galluogi i greu arwyddion newydd i hyrwyddo'r sioe a'i hadrannau. STATKRAFT ALLTWALIS WIND FARM COMMUNITY BENEFIT TRUST FUND ANNUAL REPORT 2025

Statkraft Alltwalis Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund was established to manage and distribute the community fund set up by Statkraft within the electoral ward of Llanfihangel ar Arth. Statkraft have committed to paying the annual sum of £75,000 for 25 years over the life of the project for the benefit of the local community. This sum is linked to the retail price index and will increase annually by any increases in the retail price index. During 2025 Statkraft transferred the sum of £134,883 to the fund.

Meinir Evans is the appointed Administrator for the trust fund.

AIMS OF THE FUND:

- Fund activities that create a vibrant community including those with a focus on environmental, educational and community improvement projects, including outdoor activities.
- To provide not more than 50% of matched funding for community projects and initiatives that should ordinarily be funded by Carmarthenshire County Council

Some examples of the type of projects the Fund will support are given below:

- Projects to improve public amenities e.g. community halls, sports facilities;
- Environmental and wildlife projects including projects to improve public parks and open spaces;
- Activities / events to engage the local community;
- Projects that encourage and promote education, skills and opportunities for young people;
- Energy efficiency or renewable energy projects, such as insulation, efficient boilers or small-scale renewable energy installations for community amenities.

The above list is not exhaustive and is provided to give ideas only.

Eligible Organisations:

Eligible Organisations, who can apply for funding include:

- Voluntary and community groups
- Llanfihangel ar Arth Community Council and Llanllwni Community Council
- Schools and educational establishments (for projects above LEA responsibility)
- Social enterprises (including credit unions, co-operatives, social firms, community owned enterprises, community interest companies and development trusts) provided they operate on a not-for-profit basis.

Applicants are required to have a written constitution, a set of rules, or a governing document and a bank or building society account, held in the name of the organisation, in place before applying for a grant. Applicants will also need to provide three quotes for all the project costs and 2 quotes for costs that are up to £10k.

Grant Bach -

The Statkraft Alltwalis Wind Farm Community Fund has established a Grant Bach for clubs and societies to apply for to the value of £750. The purpose of grant bach is to consider applications for the costs of equipment, concert or event costs and educational trips. (in the case of educational trips, applications will be limited to one educational trip per year.)

APPLICATIONS SUPPORTED IN 2025

During the 2025 calendar year, 18 applications were supported, including improvements to the play equipment at the playing field at Cae Chwarae Parc y Glyn, Llanfihangel-ar-arth; support for the Cylchoedd Meithrin in Llanllwni and Pencader; equipment and pitch hire costs for Pencader Junior Football Club; and the creation of a new wildlife habitat for educational purposes at Cae Hafan.

Parc y Glyn Playing Field Llanfihangel ar Arth

A grant was awarded to Cae Chwarae Parc y Glyn to install new accessible equipment for the parc.



Receiving the grant has given the committee an enormous boost and has ensured that we are seeing the fruits of our labour! We are a very hardworking committee that holds events throughout the year, and it is a pleasure to be able to give back to the children who enjoy our events by developing the park! The grant has enabled us to realise plans that we have been discussing for years. Developing the park has also raised public awareness of Parc y Glyn, and we are seeing more and more people using the park and supporting our events in general. We are proud to be able to offer equipment that is inclusive for slightly older children and for children with disabilities.

Cae Hafan Wildlife

The costs of creating a wildlife area to improve habitat and bio diversity for educational purposes was supported.



As the first external grant funding that the Cae Hafan initiative has received, the Statkraft grant has been crucial to getting things started, has allowed us to establish a strong foundation and meant we are able to move forwards in a meaningful manner and make real and effective progress towards our long term goals. West Wales Rivers Trust has helped us build our first otter holt on the reserve and on the basis that the grant from the Statkraft fund is enabling us to create the new wildlife habitats and educational area within the reserve, we have very recently gained funding to pilot our nature based educational programmes into local primary schools in future years. This would not have been possible without the help from the Statkraft fund.

Canolfan Calon Tysul Leisure Centre: A grant to matchfund and OPCC grant to install a CCTV system and access control.

Calon Tysul's Access Control/CCTV project has helped us to make our Centre safer and our users experience more valuable.

The access control installation has created a safer and more controllable environment for all our users to enjoy our Health & Wellbeing Services. All users/members now have membership cards or pay for access at our point of entry. The access control system also protects us financially, ensuring that all entrants either have an active subscription or have paid the guest fee.



The CCTV system in partnership with the access control has provided a safer environment for all team and users. All areas of the Centre are now visible at all times allowing Calon Tysul team members to be more pro active, react quicker and prevent accidents and incidents before they occur. The CCTV also supports us with our safeguarding compliance, protecting and supporting all our younger users in being more visible.

Both of these systems have increased our security and safety during opening and closing hours. These systems also help us to support our lone workers with an added layer of entrance restrictions and observational awareness.



Misfits RC Drift Club Pencader – It was agreed to support the cost of establishing the Pencader RC Misfits club.

Eisteddfod Llanfihangel ar Arth a'r Plwyf

A grant was awarded to support the costs of holding an Eisteddfod. The grant was used towards prizes at the Eisteddfod in order to try to attract more competitors across the various sections.

As a committee, we would like to extend our sincere thanks to Statkraft for their generous financial support towards Eisteddfod Llanfihangel-ar-Arth a'r Plwyf 2026. We are extremely grateful to have received this grant, which was a great help in securing a full day of competition and celebrating local talent across all age groups. It was wonderful to see the hall full throughout the day, with excellent support from the community. Financial support such as this is incredibly important in enabling us to offer generous prizes and to encourage more people to take part and compete in the Eisteddfod. The competition was enthusiastic, with over 200 homework entries and around 100 competitors taking to the stage! Thank you wholeheartedly for helping to make the event a great success. Pictured below is the Prifardd (Winning Bard) and winner of the Eisteddfod's Tlws yr Ifanc (Young Person's Trophy) with the proud adjudicator, Mr Gary Owen.



Pencader Junior Football Club: The fund supported an application for the hire costs of an astro pitch and for the purchase of equipment for Pencader Junior Football Club.



We are extremely fortunate to have received a grant towards equipment and hiring the astroturf pitch, enabling us to play our home games when the regular pitch is too wet. Without the generous support of Statkraft, our children would not have been able to play their home games. As more children join us, and with changes to the rules and regulations from the Football Association of Wales, it is becoming increasingly difficult to keep up with the resources needed. Given that we are in a low-income area, we are aware that we cannot ask for more from parents.

It is vital for us that the club is inclusive and available to everyone—no child should be left out. We are extremely grateful for the generosity of Statkraft. The support has made a real difference and has enabled us to continue to grow and thrive as a club. Thank you sincerely for being part of our journey this season. As a club that is constantly growing, we are using a lot of equipment.

Paddlers: A grant to contribute

towards the costs of a 9 seater mini bus was approved.

Receiving the grant from the Alltwalis Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund has made a huge difference to Llandysul Paddlers. It enabled us to purchase a 9-seater minibus,

which is already being used to transport our paddlers to races, training sessions, and camps across the UK. Having our own reliable transport has improved accessibility for our members, reduced travel costs, and made it easier for young people and volunteers to take part in events. It has also strengthened our sense of community and teamwork, allowing us to continue promoting outdoor activity, wellbeing, and sporting achievement. We are extremely grateful for this support, which is having a lasting positive impact on our club and members.

Cylch Meithrin Llanllwni: The Cylch was awarded a grant 'We are extremely grateful for the grant that allows us to continue to provide educational and enriching experiences to the pre school children of the area. The contribution ensures that the children receive varied valuable experiences on a daily basis under the Leadership of experienced and committed staff. As a result of the grant the Cylch has remained open all day on Wednesday since September 2023 and because of the result of the success of opening all day on Wednesday, we are now also open all day on Monday since April 2025 by offering affordable childcare for the families of the area. As a small charity we are reliant on the support of funders and grants such as Statkraft Alltwalis Community benefit fund really make a difference. Thank you for your support.



Cylch Meithrin Pencader: A grant was awarded to Cylch Meithrin.



Receiving a grant from the Fund has made a huge difference to the Cylch Meithrin. Most significantly, it has taken financial pressure off the committee, enabling us to focus on running the group day-to-day without as much worry about costs. Thanks to the funding, we have been able to continue running sessions regularly and offer a safe, warm and welcoming environment for the children. It has also helped us to purchase new resources and educational equipment, which enriches the children's learning experiences and better supports their development. In addition, the grant has enabled us to keep fees affordable for families, ensuring that more children are able to attend the group. It has also provided greater stability for the staff and volunteers, strengthening Welsh-language provision in the local community. Overall, the grant has ensured that the Cylch Meithrin is able to continue operating successfully and sustainably, having a positive impact on children and families in the area.

Pencader and District Regeneration Group

The Fund continued to support the costs of publishing and distributing Clecs Bro Cader newsletter: 'The Stakraft funding has enabled this group to publish the local newsletter "Clecs Bro Cader" six times a year, with 1,150 copies printed and distributed to keep residents up to date with events in the Parish and encourage them to join in with their community activities. It has never been an option to charge residents for the newsletter and advertising income is not enough to keep the publication going so the Statkraft funding has been invaluable.'



Neuadd yr Ysgol Llanfihangel ar Arth- an application was supported for painting and decorating Neuadd yr Ysgol.

The decorating work has contributed to creating a welcoming atmosphere for Neuadd yr Ysgol which is a focal point for the community and cultural events of Llanfihangel ar Arth and the wider community.



Yr Ardd: The costs of creating a sensory garden was supported as well as courses with Selena Walker.

Thank you to Statkraft for kindly providing funding towards the herb garden in Yr Ardd community garden, Pont tyweli, Llandysul. Thanks to the many volunteers who have helped to build and create the herb garden, it is now established as a thriving growing area. We have a lot more to learn and this is an amazing foundation for the future. People enjoy sitting in the designated area, helping themselves to the many varieties of produce and appreciating the gentle sound of water trickling down through the water feature.



Salena Walker has given us advise and help to create our own tinctures for many different ailments.

We are now in the process of inviting Salena back to Yr Ardd to show us how to dry the herbs that we have grown this year. By popular demand we are starting to create a memory garden for lost loved ones and attaching plaques on the benches that were funded by Statkraft.

Ysgol Cae'r Felin: A grant to Improve the school's outdoor area and resources for physical and wellbeing of learners was approved.

We have updated our external lighting system at the school. The lights are LED and illuminate the school's outdoor area excellently. This is very beneficial to the school when there are activities after school hours, especially during the winter. The design project was run over a period of six weeks. The project brief was to develop the classroom and transform it into a space that promotes positive mental health and mindfulness. During the project, pupils developed a range of skills:

- **Numeracy:** By measuring and creating a scale plan of the classroom;
- **Expressive Arts:** By creating a collage and experimenting with various painting techniques;
- **Literacy:** By preparing and confidently and effectively presenting their findings and hard work to parents.

The project was an exciting opportunity to integrate practical learning with personal development, providing pupils with a platform to showcase their creativity and communication skills.



Ysgol Eglwys Llanllwni : A grant was awarded to the Llanllwni School Parents and Teachers Association to support the health and wellbeing of learners.

With your support, we have been able to appoint a dedicated member of staff who focuses on promoting the health and wellbeing of our pupils. This role also provides essential support to pupils with additional learning needs, as well as those experiencing anxiety and challenges with emotional literacy.

An additional grant was approved for the costs of repairing the floor of the mobile classroom and resources for learners with additional learning needs.

Grant Bach: The grant bach was introduced as an opportunity for clubs and societies to submit applications for amounts up to £750 in value during 2025.

Llanllwni YFC: Llanllwni YFC's application to purchase resources to facilitate the arrangements for the Annual Show and to create an area to entertain children was supported.



Statkraft grant funding has been enormously valuable to Llanllwni YFC Show, enabling us to expand and improve the event for the benefit of the whole community. As this is a charitable show, the financial support gives us the opportunity to give something back to the community by creating a fun and attractive day for everyone, as well as supporting charities that make a real difference to the lives of local residents. Last year, the grant was used to provide a bouncy castle and to establish a very popular children's village, which added an exciting new element to the show. It also enabled us to create new signage to promote the show and its sections. In essence, the grant has made a significant difference by enabling us to develop and grow the show in a way that continues to benefit the wider community.

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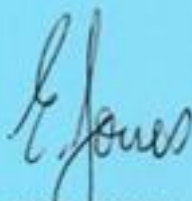
