


About the Site Site Location & Potential

- Project at Scoping stage. Scoping live 11 May 21.
- Proposing a maximum of up to 26 wind turbines.
- Considering turbines up to 200 metres tip height.
- Project size to be determined as studies are completed, consultation feedback received, and future design milestones reached.
- The site was previously part of the proposed Ardchonnel Wind Farm proposed by RWE Innogy. This is a new and separate application with no involvement from RWE Innogy.
- Where relevant, findings of the previous application have been, and will continue to be, taken into account.





About the Site Site Location & Potential

- The project team are continuing to refine the design of the windfarm based on the findings of ongoing baseline studies.
- The proposed scoping layout for 26 turbines is shown on the right.
- Turbine numbers, tip heights and locations are still to be fixed.
- The layout will be finalised following completion of studies and community consultation feedback.
