West Andershaw Wind Farm Proposal

We would like to tell you more about ourselves and our proposal for an extension to the west of Andershaw Wind Farm, of up to 11 turbines.



We are bringing forward a proposal for West Andershaw Wind Farm, with the nearest turbine of the current layout located approximately 3.3km south of Glespin, 4km west of Crawfordjohn and 4.9km south of Douglas in South Lanarkshire.

The existing 11 turbine site has been producing renewable energy since 2016 and to date has contributed nearly £500,000 of community benefit funds to the local area.

New community benefit funding and initiatives will be available through the West Andershaw project, if consented, and we look forward to exploring these with you and hearing your ideas.

We continue to follow Scottish Government advice in relation to Covid-19 and are holding a series of online consultation events, where you can find out more about our plans and help shape the project.


